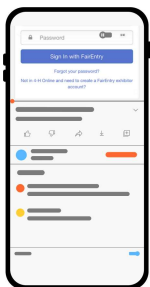

1. All Rules and Regulations established by the Missouri State Fair must be followed.
2. A registration fee of \$25.00 is required for each animal exhibited.
3. A reduced gate fee of \$15 (or a season pass) is also required for all individuals entering the grounds. Wristbands will be provided upon exit for re-entry at any time on the same day.
4. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection, dated within 30 days of the show, is **REQUIRED** for ALL animals. Additionally, all animals must have a USDA ID Tag (for Cattle/Hogs) or a Scrapie tag (for Goats/Sheep).
5. Exhibitors will declare their own weight, and scales will be available. If the participant was part of the Montgomery County Fair market show, the official fair weight will be considered.
6. There will be three age divisions for showmanship within each species.
7. Any 4-H or FFA participants from the Market Show will not need to remove their animal from the grounds after the auction if they are also participating in the Open Show.
8. Awards and Premiums will be given for Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Market Division and Grand Champion and Reserve Champion Breeding Division for each species. In addition, premiums will be paid out to class winners.

JACKPOT HOG SHOW - Friday, July 24th

Open to all exhibitors ages 21 and under.

Check-in & Weigh-In at 7:30am - 8:30am - Show starts at 9:00am

1. All hogs will be shown by breed. Purebred and Crossbred classes available.
2. Barrows and Gilts will be shown separately.
3. All breeds with less than 5 entries will fall into an Open division.

JACKPOT GOAT SHOW - Friday, July 24th

1. All Lambs shown must be a wether or an ewe (male Lamb must be castrated).

OPEN CATTLE SHOW - Saturday, July 25th

Open to all exhibitors ages 21 and under.

Check-in & Weigh-In at 8:00am - 9:00am - Show starts 9:30am

1. All cattle will be exhibited by breed, with Steers and Heifers presented in separate categories.
2. Class assignments will be determined at the chairperson's discretion. Any classes lacking sufficient entries will be combined into an open class.
3. A Market Heifer division will be offered.
