1. Exhibits will be accepted from 8:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. on Monday, July 19 and remain on display until the close of the fair.
2. Judging will begin at 11:30 a.m. on the day of entry.
3. All products shown must be produced by the exhibitor.
4. All crops not otherwise designated (*), must be grown in the current crop year.
5. All entries must be exhibited in a neat and substantial container.
6. Limit of six (6) entries per family and one entry per category per exhibitor.
7. Any category with less than three entries will be considered a novelty class and not be judged, but will receive a second place premium.
8. Any other farm crop exhibits will be welcome, but without premium.
9. Judging criteria is based on marketability of the exhibit.
