1. Exhibits will be accepted from 8:30 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. on Monday, JULY 18 and remain on display until the close of the fair.
2. Judging will begin at 11:30 a.m. on the day of entry.
3. All products shown must be produced by the exhibitor.
4. All crops not otherwise designated (*), must be grown in the current crop year.
5. All entries must be exhibited in a neat and substantial container.
6. Limit of one entry per category per exhibitor.
7. Any category with less than three entries will be considered a novelty class and not be judged, but will receive a second place premium.
8. Any other farm crop exhibits will be welcome, but without premium.
9. Judging criteria is based on marketability of the exhibit.

1. Shelled Corn - 1 Peck
2. Grain Sorghum - 1 Peck
3. Wheat - 1 Peck
4. Barley - 1 Peck
5. Soybeans - 1 Peck
6. Stalk of Corn
7. Collection of Mixed Green Vegetables
8. Cabbage (One head)
9. Potatoes (Plate of four)
10. Cherry or Grape Tomatoes (Plate of four)
11. Onions (plate of four, do not peel)

BUNDLE & SHEAF

- Must be three inches in diameter and tied in three places.
12. Pepper (Plate of four)
 13. Squash (one)
 14. Zucchini (one)
 15. Sweet Corn (Plate of four ears)
 16. Cucumbers (Plate of four)
 17. Green Beans (Plate of 10)
 18. Beets (Plate of four)
 19. Miscellaneous Root Crop—carrots, parsnips (Plate of four)
 20. Jar of Honey
 21. Apiary Products (Comb and/or beeswax products)
 22. Container/Patio Garden with potted/living plants
 23. Miscellaneous
