Open to ALL Exhibitors

Check-in & Weigh-In at 9:00am, Gilt Show starts at 10:00am

1. All hogs will be shown by breed.
 2. Barrows and Gilts will be shown separately.
 3. All breeds with less than 5 entries will fall into an Open Pure Bred division.
 4. Exhibitors will declare their own weight. Scales will be available. If the participant was in the MoCo Fair market show, the official fair weight will be used.
 5. There will be four age divisions for showmanship.
 6. Any 4-H or FFA participants from the Market Show will not be required to remove their animal from the grounds after auction if participating in the Open Show.

SHEEP & GOAT SHOW - Friday, July 19th

Open to ALL Exhibitors

Check-in & Weigh-In at 1:00pm, Show starts at 1:30pm

1. All sheep shown must be a wether or an ewe (male sheep must be castrated).
 2. All goats shown must be a wether or a doe (male goats must be castrated).
 3. Exhibitors will declare their own weight. Scales will be available. If the participant was in the MoCo Fair market show, the official fair weight will be used.
 4. Any 4-H or FFA participants from the Market Show will not be required to remove their animal from the grounds after auction if participating in the Open Show.

CATTLE SHOW - Saturday, July 20th

Open to ALL Exhibitors

Check-in & Weigh-In at 9:00am, Heifer Show starts at 10:00am

1. All cattle will shown by breed, with Steers and Heifers shown separately.
2. All breeds with less than 5 entries will fall into an Open Pure Bred division.
3. A Market Heifer division will be available.
4. Exhibitors will declare their own weight. Scales will be available. If the participant was in the MoCo Fair market show, the official fair weight will be used.
5. There will be four age divisions for showmanship.
6. Any 4-H or FFA participants from the Market Show will not be required to remove their animal from the grounds after auction if participating in the Open Show.
