All Horses must have a negative coggins. Novice Classes are for riders in their first or second year of competition. Novice Classes are walk/trot only. No loping.

All exhibitors are required to wear their entry number in judged classes and must have appropriate tack and equipment. Helmets are highly encouraged in all class and **required in speed classes for ages 12 and under**. No running through gate for speed events. Horsemanship classes may use English or Western tack and attire.
