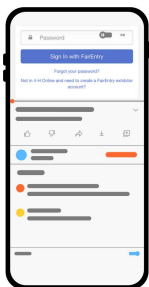

# MoCo Fair Youth Poultry Fun Show

Wednesday, July 22 - Livestock Arena - Following Poultry Show

Registration Fee- \$3 per bird - Pre-Registration REQUIRED online!

1. **ONLINE REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED** at <https://mocoair.fairentry.com> until July 12.
2. A Pullorum-Typhoid Test is required or proof that the bird is part of a pullorum-typhoid free flock. State Vet will be on hand to test chickens prior to the open shows.
3. All APA (American Poultry Association) rules apply unless otherwise mentioned below.
4. Youth from the ages of 5 to 18 are eligible to show.
5. Youth exhibitors must handle their own birds. Poultry handled by adults will be disqualified.
6. No cooping is available. Exhibitors must provide cages for birds to stay in before and after judging.
7. Each exhibitor is required to see that their animal gets to the show table.
8. Montgomery County Fair is not responsible for loss in case of fire, theft, accident, or preventable destruction. However, all precautions will be taken to prevent the same.
9. The decisions of the chairmen and judges are final.
10. All participants must pay a Gate fee (or use season pass) to get on grounds.
11. Any animals deemed sick by the judge/show official will be removed from the show.
12. Food and water for all poultry is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
13. There is a limit of 2 birds per exhibitor, per class.
14. Awards will be given for:
  - a. Best of Show and Reserve of Show
  - b. Best of Class
  - c. Reserve of Class and 3rd in Class
  - d. All exhibited poultry will receive a participation ribbon

### Rules:

- The show will be open to all youth ages 18 and under.
- ONLINE REGISTRATION IS PREFERRED at <https://mcofair.fairentry.com> until **July 18**. Will be able to register day of show from 10:30 to 11:30am
- Animals must be shown by registered exhibitor.
- Exhibitors are limited to three entries per class.
- Show will be according to ARBA and State Fair Rules. The show management reserves the right to interpret the rules or make any decisions regarding the show deemed necessary in the best interest of the event.

### Classes:

#### 4 Class Rabbits

(Breed examples: Netherland Dwarfs, Mini Rex, Mini Lop, Lionheads, Dutch)

1. Senior Buck (over 7 months old)
2. Senior Doe (over 7 months old)
3. Junior Buck (6 months and under)
4. Junior Doe (6 months and under)

#### 6 Class Rabbits

(Breed examples: New Zealand, Californian, French & Eng. Lop, Silver Fox)

5. Senior Buck (over 9 months old)
6. Senior Doe (over 9 months old)
7. Intermediate Buck (6-8 months old)
8. Intermediate Doe (6-8 months old)
9. Junior Buck (6 months and under)
10. Junior Doe (6 months and under)

#### Other:

11. Single Fryer (Purchased)  
(under 70 days old & within weight range of 3-6lbs)
12. Meat Pen - 2 of a kind (Purchased)  
(under 70 days old & within weight range of 3-6lbs)
13. Single Fryer (Home Raised)  
(Exhibitor must own & kindled the offspring at their home to be eligible to enter this class)
14. Meat Pen - 2 of a Kind (Home Raised)  
(Exhibitor must own & kindled the offspring at their home to be eligible to enter this class)
