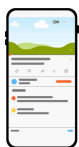

2. Judging will begin at 11:00 a.m. on the day of entry.
3. All products shown must be produced by the exhibitor.
4. All crops not otherwise designated (\*), must be grown in the current crop year.
5. All entries must be exhibited in a neat and substantial container.
6. Limit of one entry per category per exhibitor.
7. Any category with less than three entries will be considered a novelty class and not be judged, but will receive a second place premium.
8. Any other farm crop exhibits will be welcome, but without premium.
9. Judging criteria is based on marketability of the exhibit.

Displays must be dismantled on Sunday following the Fair's conclusion (11:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.).

This competition is open to all not-for-profit organizations in Montgomery County, including FFA Chapters, 4-H Clubs, Extension Clubs, Soil & Water District, and more.
